WESTERNERS HISTORY MINUTE

On December 18, 1948 in Sweetwater, Texas, about 175 dancers got together to form the Westerners Square and Round Dance Association. They elected officers, drew up bylaws and were incorporated. The officers included President, 1st Vice Pres., 2nd Vice Pres. 3rd Vice Pres., Secretary and Treasurer.

Notes from a Westerners Board meeting in 1949 included the statement that "no caller was to be paid for his services and that callers would not be allowed free admission to the dances." Only the names of Westerner callers were listed in the programs. This "was not intended to be unfriendly," but it was so that their names would not be omitted from the program.
